
BABSON COLLEGE

The Glavin Office οf International Education's International Student and Scholar Services (ISSS) is committed to providing culturally sensitive comprehensive advisory services of the highest quality to Babson's international students and scholars and their families. We educate and advise on ever-changing U.S. immigration regulations and provide outreach and support when events may affect our international population. As we do so, we are mindful of each student's unique experiences and complex identity (including but not limited nationality, heritage, faith, gender, sexual orientation and socio-economic status).

As a snapshot in time for the fall semester, the ISSS annual report illustrates Babson's international population but does not capture all of the students/scholars with whom we work in a given year. Statistics not captured in this report include students only enrolled in the spring or summer semesters, Executive Education, Babson Academy programs, or part-time graduate programs.

While this report also does not capture the 274 U.S. dual citizens or 114 U.S. Permanent

Residents, we recognize that they bring additional perspectives that further enrich our campus community.

Fall 2020 data displays how the institution was impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic as global mobility was halted. A majority of our international students, especially newly admitted students, were not able to physically come to campus due to travel restrictions and visa processing delays. However. thanks the innovation to throughout our community. impacted international students had academic continuity 100% online or through our Babson in China program.

It continues to be a privilege to work with our diverse international population and with colleagues across campus who also strive to maintain Babson's commitment to creating a welcoming, affirming and inclusive community for all students. 38 new undergraduate students and 58 new graduate students arrived to the U.S. for the fall 2020 semester.




58% undergraduate and 17% graduate students maintained academic continuity by pursuing a full course of study from their home countries around the world.

Undergraduate: 27%




Graduate: 22%


Regional Diversity



Countries Most Represented








J-1 Exchange Students


Visa Representation
